General Information

Arrival:

The High School will open at 1:30 P.M. All guards & staff MUST enter through the South End of the building stated on the map/directions. Your guard will be assigned a greeter who will assist you for the evening and keep you on time. Hand stamps are required and each director will be asked to sign a "Director Accountability" form (enclosed).

Parking and Props:

Guard buses can be parked in the South End parking lot. All equipment trucks can be parked in the Fieldhouse lot, however, the equipment and Prop entrance will be locked 30 minutes after the awards presentation. The front doors to the High School will remain open until 10:30 P.M. All equipment and props will enter through the Field House garage doors as stated on the map/ directions. NOTE: Only guard members and staff/crew persons (7) will be able to use this entrance. You will receive 7 wristbands for your staff when checking in. All spectators MUST use the main entrance at the front door. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Dressing:

Each guard will be assigned a room in the school. Your staff/director will be held accountable for the room & its contents. **DO NOT** go through desk drawers or items that may have been left out by the teacher. Please leave your room as you found it. Please no eating or drinking in your room. Also if you are using glitter (makeup) please apply it in the bathroom facility. An adult must be present in the room whenever there are students in it. **NO USE** of equipment is permitted outside the prop warm-up areas. **Please, NO Glitter in the class rooms, ONLY use Glitter in the Restrooms**.

Tickets:

Guard members will be allowed into the gym for back side seating.


DIRECTIONS TO LANCASTER HIGH SCHOOL 1 Forton Drive Lancaster, NY 14086




GUARD / PROPS ~ FLOW DIAGRAM
