



Welcome to "Artistry in Motion"

Welcome and thank you for choosing to participate in Marcus Whitman's Winterguard Home Show, "Artistry in Motion," being held on **Saturday, February 29, 2020 at 5:00pm!** We are excited to have the opportunity once again to be able to host this event and are looking forward to our time together. This is bitter-sweet for us as our gym has hosted guards performing for decades and decades. Although we are looking forward to this new capital project, we are sad to say goodbye to this historical gym. Here is some important information we would like to share with you.

Our main doors will open for guards and spectators at 3:00pm. The gym doors will open at 4:30pm, our National Anthem will be played at 4:55pm, and the show will be at 5:00pm. Again, thank you for your participation!

Tickets: Tickets will be available at the door for \$6.00 for students/55+seniors and \$8.00 for adults. Credit cards will be accepted.

Guard Check In: Each participating guard will be assigned a homeroom. Because of the computers in the school, an adult guard representative must sign a form as the guard arrives stating the room will be returned to the condition in which it was found and pay for repair or replacement for broken or missing items. A GUARD REPRESENTATIVE MUST ARRIVE WITH THE MEMBERS AND SIGN THE FORM. ROOMS WILL NOT BE ASSIGNED UNTIL THIS HAS BEEN DONE.

Guards should be dropped off at the Wayne-Finger Lakes Secondary School (BOCES at Marcus Whitman) parking lot entrance located at the rear of the building. Your guard members will be stamped upon entering the building and they will be directed to your room. Props and equipment should enter at the same entrance. The circuit is using Competition Suite and scores and comments will be sent to you through your phone, computer or other digital device.

Please note only instructors and chaperones will be allowed in the guard areas. If you have guard members going home with parents, please make arrangements in advance to the parents meet them in the cafeteria.

Video: We will be providing an area for you to video your own team.

Pre-Performance Announcements: All announcements should be typed and clearly labeled with your guard name and the time of your performance. Announcements should be turned in immediately upon check in. Please clarify wording with announcer when you do a sound check. You may also email announcements to heatherkayclark20@gmail.com.

Sound Checks: Sound checks will be allowed from 3:30pm until 4:30pm and again during intermission (around 6:01-6:46pm) only.

Bus Parking: Once your guard has been dropped off at the guard check in area, your buses can unload props and park in the same parking lot. We are asking all buses and equipment vehicles to park in the BOCES parking lot located at the rear of the building.

Equipment: All equipment MUST be carefully padded with special attention to all sabers. All equipment will be inspected before entering the gym.

No props will be checked in before 3:00pm.

Floors: The guards will be entering the gym from the left side of judges and they will exit the gym using the doors on the right. Both of these doors are located near the back of the performance floor. When you are folding your floor mat, you will drop it along the left side and pull across to the right.

Cafeteria: The cafeteria will be open as of 3:00pm with a variety of choices available. Credit cards will be accepted.

Seating: Guard members, chaperones, and your floor crew will be stamped upon arrival. The Northeast circuit allows a total of 7 staff, chaperones, and floor crew combined per unit. Floor crew will be stamped at the prop entrance. These members will be allowed to view the show from **the back side of the gym** only. Since there will be limited seating for paying public, please remind your members to sit on the back side of the gym. They will be asked to move if they are sitting on the front side.

Guides: Your group will be escorted as it makes its way from your classroom to body warm up/equipment warm up area. It's the director's responsibility to follow the time schedule.

Warm Ups: There be will a body and equipment warm up period prior to your performance time. While we will provide guides, it is the responsibility of the director to make sure their guard arrives for warm ups on time.

Retreat: Captains only please. Retreat will be held immediately after the final exhibition and guard recognition. Please have your team's captains report to the hallway where the guards entered for competition immediately following the ARC's performance.

Comments & sheets: Please remember to pick up your music CD from the announcers table in the gym. Remember, comments are digital and will be received through Competition Suite along with the scores. Recaps will be available at the Post Contest meeting.

Awards: All group from each division will be receiving an award.

Post Contest Meetings: Will be held in the High School Library and will begin immediately following the show.

Smoking: There is **NO Smoking Permitted** on school grounds. Please remind your parents chaperones and floor crew of this important rule.

Directions:

From Canandaigua, NY-Take 5 & 20 East, Turn right onto NY-364 S, Turn left onto Co Rd 1, Turn left onto Baldwin Road, Destination will be on the left (first driveway for guards and equipment / third driveway for spectators).

From Geneva, NY-Take 5 & 20 West, Turn left onto NY-245 S, Turn right onto Baldwin Road, Destination will on the right (fourth driveway for guards and equipment / second driveway for spectators).

From Penn Yan, NY-Take Liberty Street, Turn left onto NY-364 W, Turn right onto NY-247 N, Continue straight onto Co Rd 1, Turn right onto Baldwin Rd, Destination will be on the left (first driveway for guards and equipment / third driveway for spectators).

From Naples, NY-Take N Main Street, Turn right onto NY-245 N, Turn left onto N Main Street, Continue straight onto Co Rd 1, Turn right onto Baldwin Rd, Destination will be on the left (first driveway for guards and equipment / third driveway for spectators).

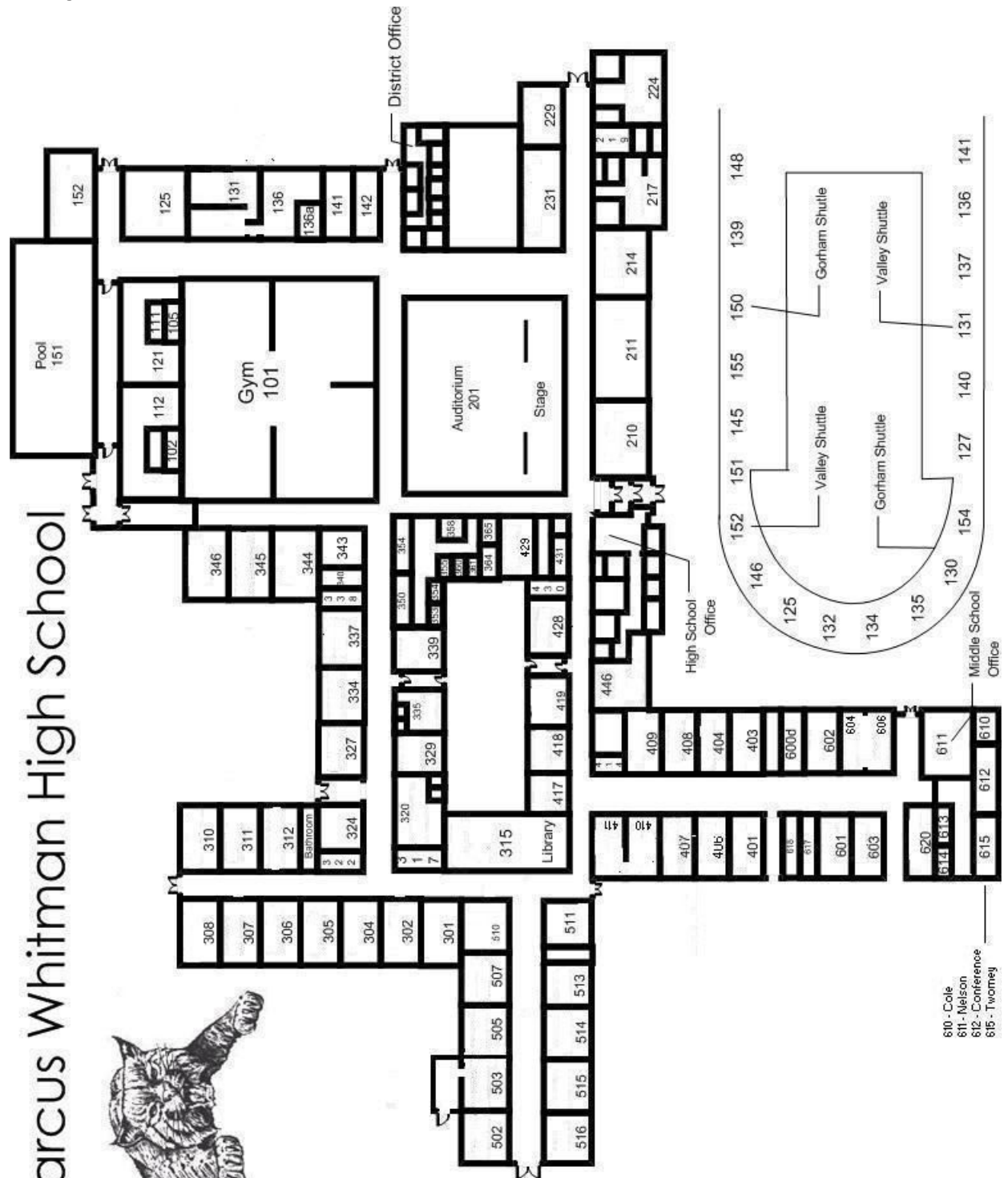
